Lost Village is a daytime focused experience with activities such as talks, workshops and wellness opening from 8:30am, then comedy and music commencing at midday.



Headline artists all play before 11pm, with music generally finishing by 1/2am. We have smaller bars and spaces that stay open until 3am. This approach means music spaces are full of energy from early in the day, helping us to support the discovery of incredible emerging artists.

The Oracle

The Oracle is our all-seeing information point. If you want to book a banquet, yoga, find out about workshops or ask any kind of question, then The Oracle is there to help.

The Oracle is located between Vintage Boutique and Creative Workshops, and is open from 3pm to 11pm on Thursday and 9am to 11pm Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

WIFI HOTSPOTS

We all know reception can be tricky at festivals. If you're struggling to connect, you can use our free WIFI hotspots, located within the Hay Barn and Village Market Place. These are also great meeting places should you lose your friends.

REUSABLE CUPS

Creating a circular system that utilises durable cups which can be used over and over again is the greenest solution for live events.

Re-usage is key and our cups will also be cleaned and used at other events too. The more they're re-used, the better it is for the planet.

1. BUY YOUR FIRST DRINK

Buy your first drink – a one-off charge of £2.00 will be applied. You won't need to pay this again!

2. RETURN YOUR CUP TO THE BAR

Next time you get a drink, take your cup to the bar and it'll be swapped for a clean one at no further cost.

3. PLEASE DON'T TAKE THESE CUPS HOME!

Any cup that exits the circular system is a step in the wrong direction. If you're finished with your cup PLEASE find a purple bin and place it in there, if we don't return it not only are we adding more plastic into the world but we have to replace at huge cost.



FULLY CARBON OFFSET INITIATIVE

We'll plant trees to fully offset the carbon emissions created by the washing and transportation of the cups too.

The OUTPOST

Tucked away in a lesser known corner of The Old Zoo, lies an area that few have ever laid eyes on... Built in 1987, it's believed that this is where the zoo's founding team came to formulate plans for their impending expeditions.

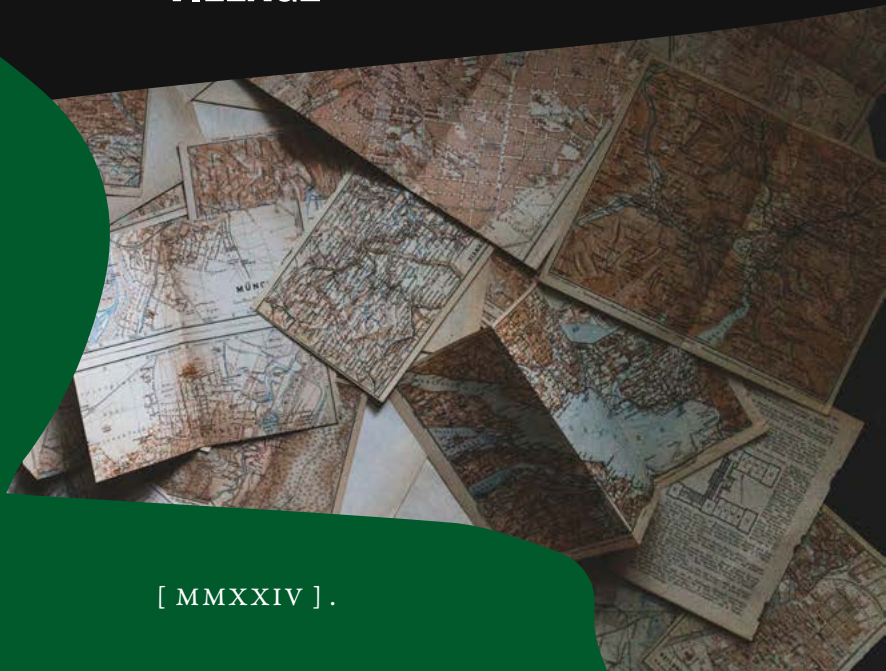

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

We conduct an annual carbon audit to calculate our output. Whilst we have long since rebalanced that output via reforestation and conservation projects, the longterm aim is to constantly look for ways to reduce output.

This year we're utilising plug-in hybrid Defenders to replace various festival vehicles, whilst installing on-site EV chargers, and using a portable Battery Energy Storage System with second-life batteries.

We'll share our annual update in early 2025.

TAKE YOUR TENT HOME

Abandoned tents are, by far, the biggest contributor to plastic waste at festivals. An average tent equates to 250 plastic pint cups or nearly 9000 straws. As we're sure you'll all agree, we cannot let this trend occur at Lost Village, especially as most abandoned festival tents end up as landfill.

Sustainability



WATER

We have free water points throughout the village. All water for sale is NOBL WATR. They use cartons made from 95% plant-based materials and produced using 100% renewable energy. We have an assigned collection for these cartons and are aiming for a 100% recycle rate.



RECYCLING

We're operating a 3 bin system for recyclables, compostable, and general waste. Please help us by using the right bins. Campers will also be given recycling bags on entry. Throughout the campsite our sustainability team, in partnership with Eco Warriorz, are offering help and advice – say hello for a chance to win prizes, including tickets to Lost Village 2025.



PRE-PITCHED CAMPING

We have introduced a closed-loop approach by offering sustainable pre-pitched camping, utilising reused tents. We also offer click-and-collect reconditioned camping equipment to reduce single use purchases.



GREENER TRAVEL

Lost Village work with National Express to provide nationwide coach routes. A full coach could take 50 cars off the road removing one mile of traffic congestion.

CARBON REBALANCE

In partnership with A Greener Future (AGF) we undertake an annual independent carbon audit. To date we have committed to rebalancing our total known Co2 emissions, following each festival, utilising our reforestation partners Tree Nation. We have offset our total known emissions by planting 19748 trees, capturing 3462.83 tonnes of Co2.
