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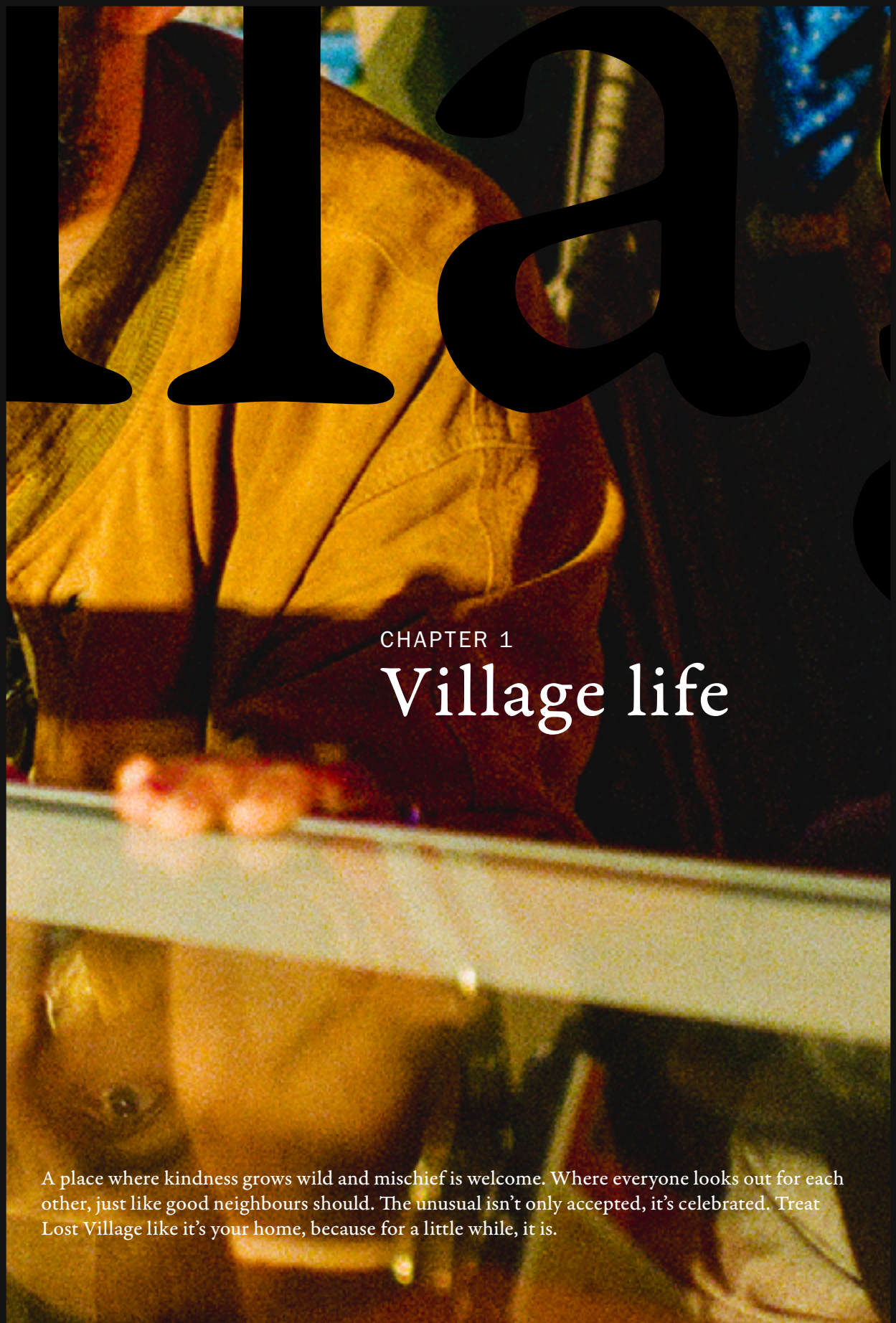

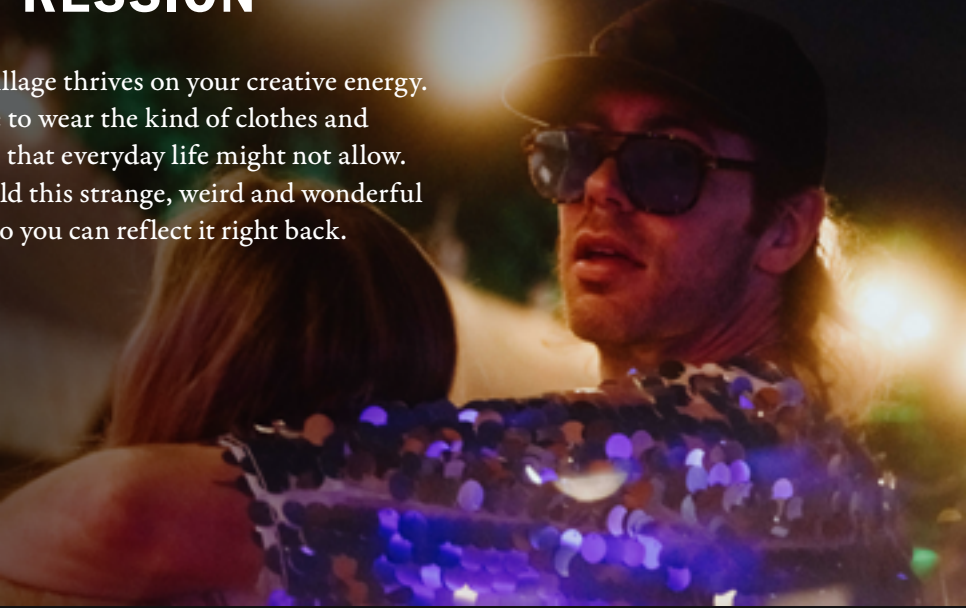
Includes cans, tins, plastic bottles, takeaway containers, clean cardboard, and empty plastic pots.

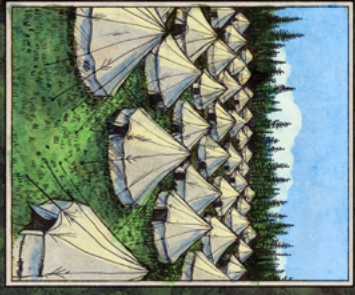
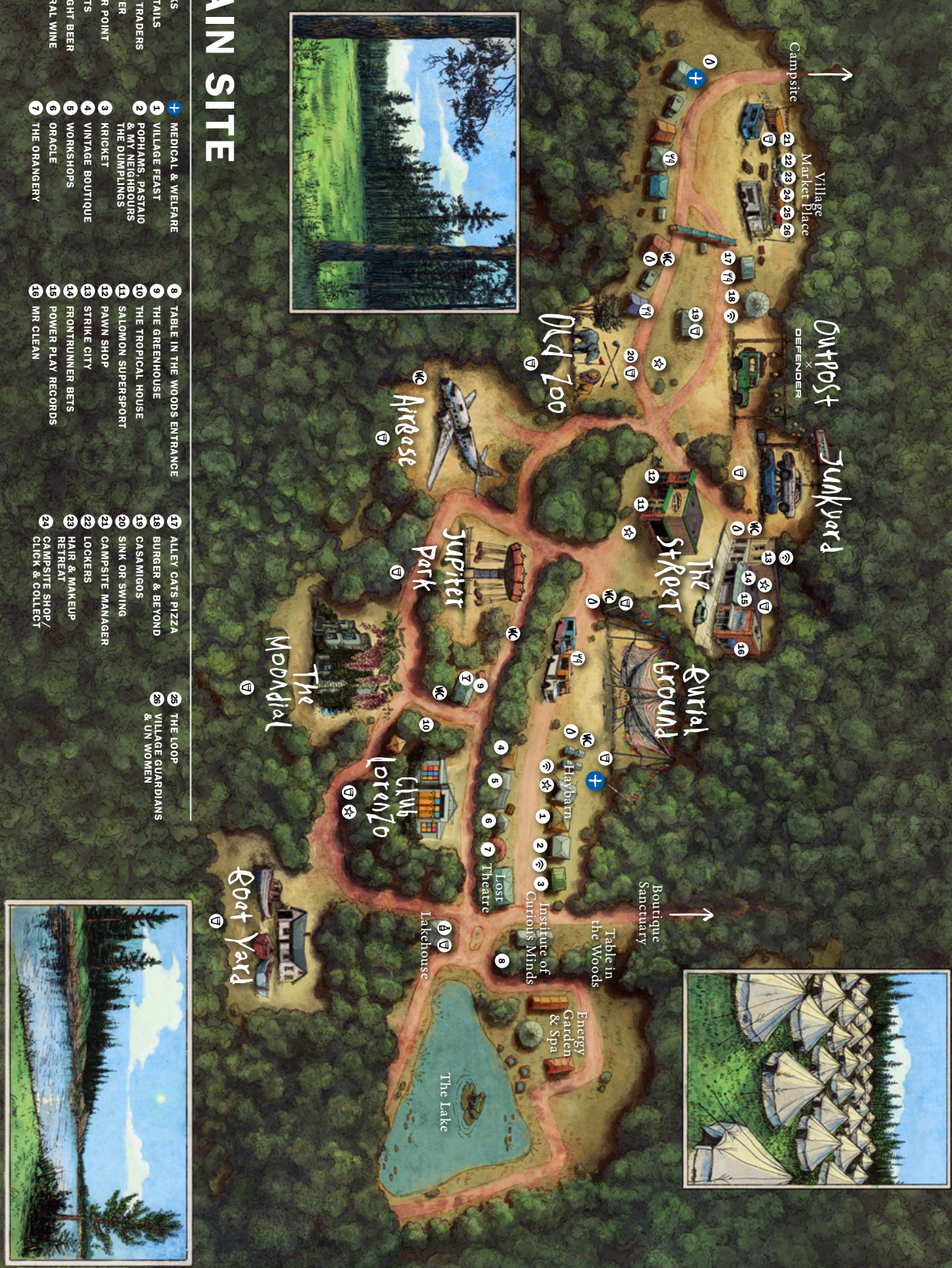

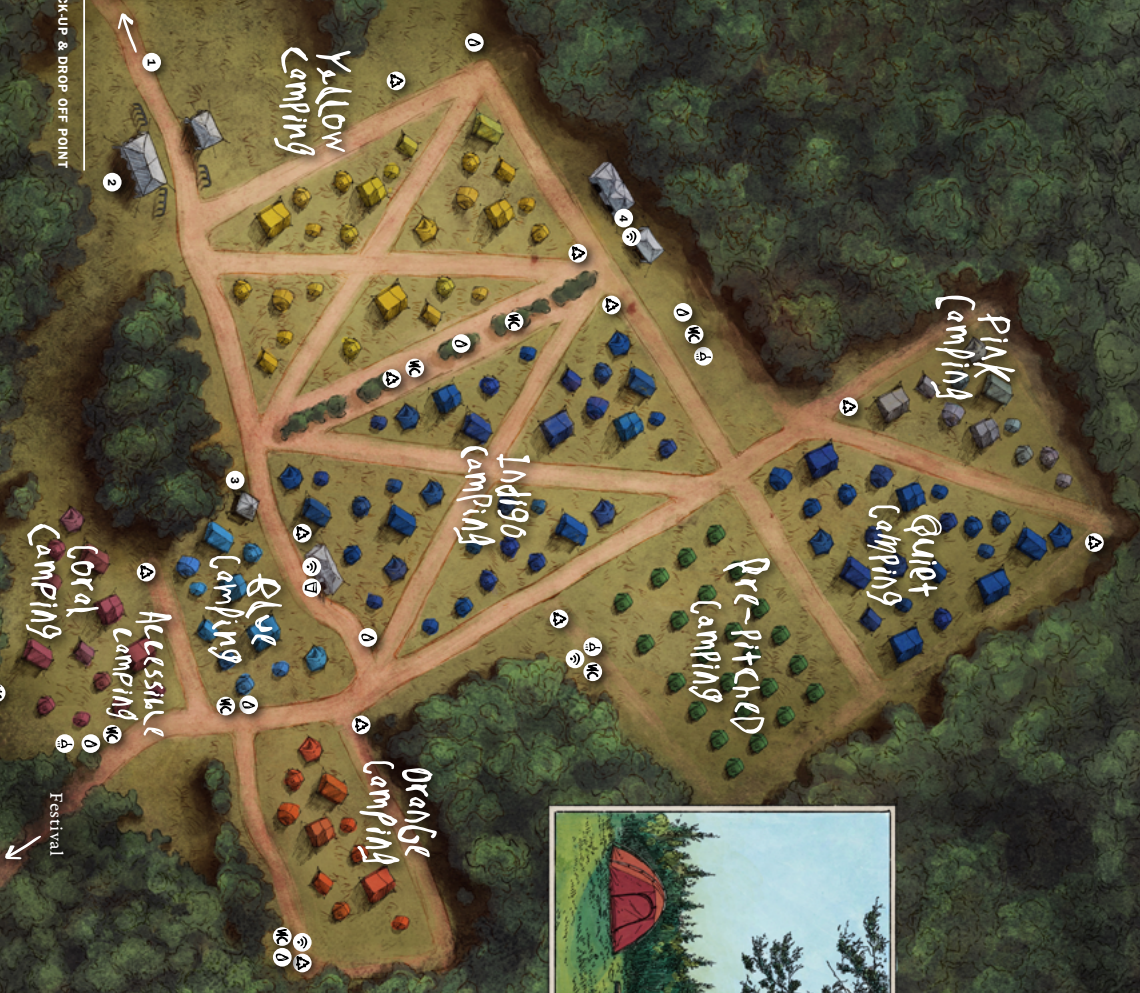

Lost Village is a daytime focused experience with activities such as talks, workshops and wellness opening from 8:30am, then comedy and music commencing at midday.



Headline artists all play before 11pm, with music generally finishing by 1/2am. We have smaller bars and spaces that stay open until 3am.

This approach means music spaces are full of energy from early in the day, helping us to support the discovery of incredible emerging artists.

BETTER FOR THE PLANET

We conduct an annual carbon audit to calculate our output — offsetting our total known emissions each year, aiming for carbon neutrality. Whilst we have undertaken many reforestation projects around the world, the long-term aim is to constantly look for ways to reduce our impact.

OUR ACTIONS

This year, we'll once again be utilising plug-in hybrid Defenders to replace various festival vehicles, reducing our use of non-renewable energy. In 2024 we installed an EV charging system into the site permanently too. This will have a notable effect on our carbon emissions and will be reported via our yearly carbon audit — we will then rebalance any carbon via our various reforestation and conservation projects.

We'll share our annual update in early 2026.

REUSABLE CUPS

Our durable cups are part of a circular system—collected, cleaned, and reused across events. The more they're used, the greener the impact.

BUY YOUR FIRST DRINK

Buy your first drink – a one-off charge of £2.00 will be applied. You won't need to pay this again!

RETURN YOUR CUP TO THE BAR

Next time you get a drink, take your cup to the bar and it'll be swapped for a clean one or a token at no further cost.

Any cup that exits the circular system is a step in the wrong direction. If you're finished with your cup PLEASE find a purple bin and place it in there, if we don't return it not only are we adding more plastic into the world but we have to replace at huge cost.

TAKE YOUR TENT HOME

Abandoned tents are by far the biggest contributor to plastic waste at festivals. The average tent equates to 250 plastic pint cups or nearly 9,000 straws. As we're sure you'll agree, this is a trend we cannot allow at Lost Village — especially as most abandoned tents end up in landfill.



WATER

Free water points are available throughout the Village and campsite. All bottled water is provided in partnership with DRIP, whose aluminium cans are infinitely recyclable. Their water is also sustainably sourced from England's South Downs.



RECYCLING

We operate a three-bin system for recycling, compostable waste (e.g. food), and general waste. Please help us by using the correct bins.

All campers will receive recycling bags on entry to help sort and manage waste responsibly. Our campsite volunteers will be on hand to offer support, share advice, and provide extra bin bags to help keep the campsite tidy.

New for 2025: We've introduced donation points across the campsite for unwanted camping equipment such as tents, airbeds, and sleeping bags. Where possible, items will be repurposed, reused, or donated to charitable causes.



PRE-PITCHED CAMPING

We've adopted a closed-loop approach by offering sustainable pre-pitched camping, utilising reused tents. We also offer click-and-collect reconditioned camping equipment to reduce single use purchases.



CARBON REBALANCE

In partnership with A Greener Future (AGF) we undertake an annual independent carbon audit. To date we have committed to rebalancing our total known Co2 emissions, following each festival, utilising our reforestation partners Tree Nation. We have offset our total known emissions by planting 27,386 trees, capturing 4433.53 tonnes of Co2. Additionally, we have successfully reduced our carbon footprint for three consecutive years.



GREENER TRAVEL

Lost Village partners with National Express to offer nationwide coach travel. A single full coach can remove up to 50 cars from the road — that's one mile of traffic congestion eliminated.

Airbase

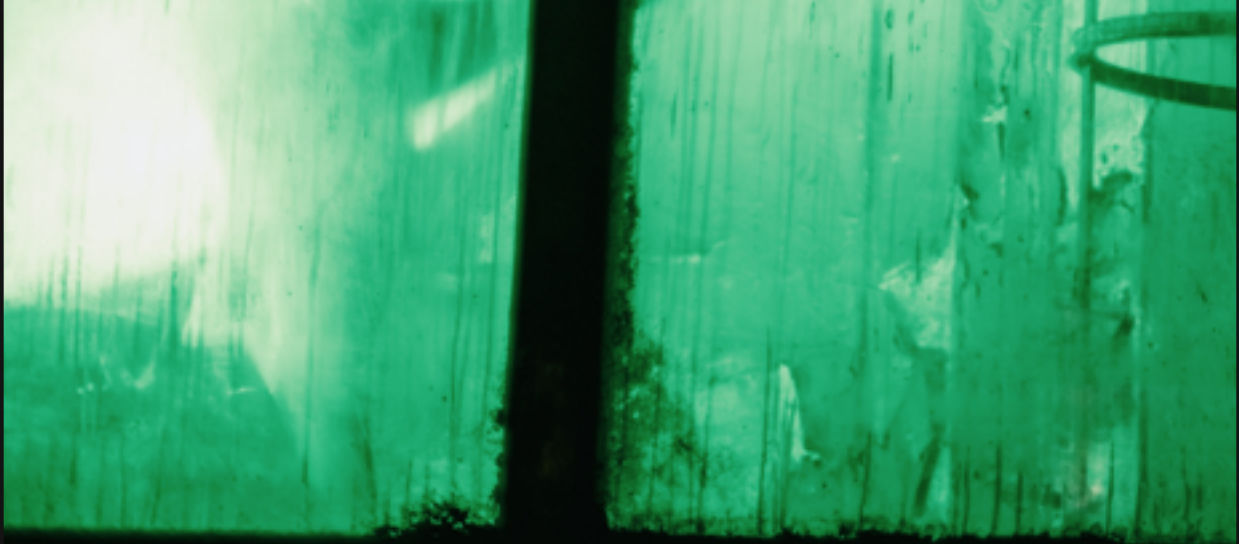


Sink or Swing

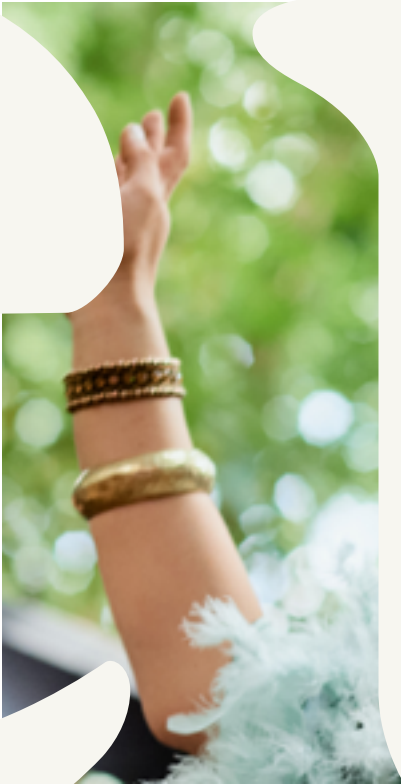

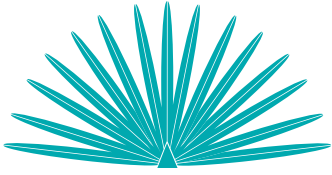
